CBI 2014 is pleased to invite you to an exclusive Gala Evening in a prestigious location in the heart of Rome: the **National Gallery of Ancient Art** of the **Corsini Palace**.

The Palace, located in rione Trastevere, in front of Villa Farnesina, was built at the end of the 15th Century, but thanks to the Corsini family, in the first half of 1700, it became wider including the previously existing building. In this fascinating setting, headquarter of the Lincei Academy, the Gallery, at the first floor, features paintings from the fourteenth to the eighteenth Century, predominantly artists, such as Rubens, Caravaggio and Beato Angelico.

The Gardens, which rise up the Janiculum hill, are part of the Orto Botanico.

The ancient part of the building hosts the room which became famous for being the apartment of Queen Christine of Sweden, an eccentric and strong woman, who among these walls maintained good political, diplomatic and artistic relationships. During the Cocktail you will be welcomed by art historians that will be at your disposal for any artistic description or historical sign about the location.

Dinner tables will spread among the gallery, in order **to dine and to live in a unique atmosphere**.
